Martin Brattrud continues to focus on low impact materials and finishes across all our products. We try to use the best-in-class and healthiest materials for our employees, clients and users. Martin Brattrud continues to assess our supply chain, and we are working to achieve as high a level of transparency as possible. We do this by constantly collecting and reviewing the bills of material and safety data from all our suppliers. As our industry advances this conversation by identifying new toxins and moving chemicals from the Priority List to the full Red List, we know this is a work in progress that will never end. We have been using Health Product Declarations to better understand the chemical composition of our products. Our effort to utilize Health Product Declarations to identify toxins throughout our entire product line is an ongoing project and one that we are entirely committed to.

Customers are responsible for specifying fabrics compliant with the Red List guidelines.

This letter serves as a declaration that, to the best of our knowledge, based on the information provided to us by our suppliers, any chemicals in our product that appear on the 2026 Red List will be noted in our Health Product Declarations. As we discover chemicals in our supply chain that appear on the Red List, we will work with suppliers to find a safer alternative.
